Changes to Electronics Recycling Program

Due to circumstances beyond our control, we have made some changes to our Electronics Recycling Program.

Items that we will no longer take for recycling are: copy machines; non-cellular telephones; digital camcorders & cameras; stereo equipment (receivers, amplifiers, car stereos, boom boxes); CDs & DVDs; floppy disks; magnetic tape; VHS, cassette & reel to reel tapes; cable boxes; shredders; large speakers; fax machines; vacuum cleaners; hair dryers & curling irons. These items may be placed with trash.

Act 108 of 2010 (The Covered Device Recycling Act), bans all covered devices from landfills, however, the Centre County Recycling & Refuse Authority offers a free drop off service for residents.

Covered Devices includes desktop computers, monitors, laptops, computer peripherals and televisions.

We will accept the items listed below.



The Recycling & Refuse Authority is located at 253 Transfer Road, in College Township. We are located between the Nittany Mall and SCI Rockview, off Route 26. To recycle your electronics, follow the signs to the Scales (Gate 1), and tell our Scale Operator what you have. They will direct you to the drop-off location. We are open Monday - Saturday from 8 am - 4 pm. This is a free service for residents only.

GUIDE TO CURBSIDE RECYCLING



MIXED PAPER, PAPERBOARD, MAGAZINES & NEWSPAPER

Must be bagged or bundled together or they will not be accepted. Bag shredded paper. Place inside bin.



PLASTIC - BOTTLES, JUGS & JARS

Rinse containers. Lids and labels acceptable.



GLASS - BOTTLES, JUGS & JARS

Rinse containers. Lids and labels acceptable.



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Break down all cardboard boxes. Place beside bin.



STEEL & ALUMINUM - CANS & FOIL

Rinse and remove food residue. Labels acceptable.
